

RHS Federal Challenge Finishes Third Place

This year, Ridgewood High School's Federal Challenge team was determined to make it to the final of the Federal Reserve Challenge. The team accomplished their goal and took third place in the final round of the competition that took place over the break.

The competition is run by the Federal Reserve Bank of New York on behalf of the entire Federal Reserve system of the United States of America for students taking economics courses. The competition asks groups of high school students to research the domestic/global economy, develop a mathematical model for forecasting the domestic economy, present their research to a panel of high ranking economists working at the FRBNY, and answer complex questions about both the team's research and the economy.
