\$2,400.00 - 2 computers (1,200 ea) for use in teacher offices.

\$320.00 - 2 portable screens at \$160 ea.

\$1,000 for departmental conferences

\$1,000 for the Distinguished Alumni Award project. Used to purchase plaques and lettering for the wall.

Total: \$16,980.00

The proposal will be voted on at the June meeting.

Principal's Report – Jack Lorenz reported that AP classes are taking the AP exams. Also, Pat Hans, an American Studies teacher at RHS, was selected as a judge for literary magazine. Congratulations to her for this very high honor.

Social Norms Program – the program will soon include tee-shirts that students can choose to wear. Students are also preparing a U-Tube type video regarding the social norms program.

On May 30, Tim Silvestre, from Lafayette University, will be at RHS to present underage drinking program, "Straight Shots."

Town ordinance on underage drinking will be going before the Village Council. RHS will probably form a high school task force, to get parents to help enact all suggestions.
